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## 2. Overview

This course API provides real time search and enquiry functionality for courses within the Jobg8 network.

The API has been designed with two purposes in mind.

1. If you are also using our iframe course solution you may want to call the API to display links to your iframe across other parts of your website. E.g. featured courses advertising banner content to be displayed alongside a job search page results, displaying associated courses to the job search.
2. If you wish to call the course content and run your own search and display function. The course content typically works on a Pay Per Lead basis so it is important that when you display search results that you then also display the full description and course enquiry form. Each time a prospective student/candidate completes an Enquiry Form this triggers a financial settlement.

This is a technical document and assumes the reader has a working knowledge of APIs and XML. Additional response details could be added in the future, therefore it's recommended that you allow for this.

This API should always be available, but it is recommended any implementation handles the eventuality that the API is unavailable or a failure message is returned.

**Please note:** It is important that you do not collect and store the course content gathered from the API. The content will change on a daily basis and it is important that the course details are always up to date. This is also restricted within our Terms of Business.

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### 3. Course API

This API exposes the following functionality:

- Search for courses
- Get full details of a course
- Get a summary of courses available

To use the API you will be provided with a unique access key.

#### 3.1 Failure Messages

A failure message will be returned if an issue is encountered calling the API. A HTTP status code is returned along with a plain text message.

List of possible failures:

HTTP Status Code	Message
401	The id provided failed authentication
400	Missing querystring parameter: {0}
400	Invalid value for querystring parameter: {0}
400	1 or more of the following parameters is required: query, type, subject
403	Forbidden
503	Service currently unavailable, please try again later

#### 3.2 Required Parameters

These parameters are required for all calls to the API:

Name	Description	Required
id	Your unique account identifier for accessing the API.	Yes
op	Indicates the function to be performed. Values are "search", "course", "summary".	Yes
ipaddress	The IP v4 address and user agent (browser) of the user. User data is required to detect and protect against excessive API calls from automatic processes such as robots. In the eventuality such a call is detected a 403 HTTP status code (forbidden) is returned.	Yes
useragent		Yes

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### 3.3 Search

#### 3.3.1 Parameters

Name	Description	Required
query	The course search query.	A minimum of one of these parameters is required
type	The course type. Values are: "Online", "Classroom", "DistanceLearning", "Software", "OnSite".	
subject	The course subject. A subject ID is expected. Appendix A lists all subjects and associated sub subjects.	
subsubject	The course sub subject. A sub subject ID is expected. When a sub subject is supplied the subject parameter is ignored. Appendix A lists all subjects and associated sub subjects	
location	Comma separated free text location. Only applies to Classroom type courses. E.g. Colchester, Essex, UK.	No
range	The search range from the location in kilometres. Default value is 10 km and the maximum value is 1000 km.	No
results	The maximum number of results returned per page. Default is 10 and the maximum value is 50.	No
page	The results page to return. Default is 1.	No

#### 3.3.2 XML Response

CourseType	The course type. One of the values is returned: "Online", "Classroom", "DistanceLearning", "Software", "OnSite".
CourseLevel	The level of course. One or more of the values is returned: "Beginner", "Intermediate", "Advanced".
StudyMode	The study mode of course. One or more of the values is returned: "Full time", "Part time".
Price	The price of the course including the currency symbol. If this value is empty then there is no pricing information available for the course.
DiscountPrice	The discounted price of the course. If there is a discount price the price element will contain value.
Location	The location(s) of the course. Only contains values for Classroom courses.
EnquiryURL	The URL to redirect the lead to.

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EnquiryType	The type of enquiry. One of the values is returned: "Form", "Traffic". Form indicates the URL is a link to a Jobg8 enquiry form. Traffic indicates the URL is a link to the course on a third party site.
ProviderName	The name of the course provider.
ProviderLogoURL	The Logo URL of the course provider.

Subject	The course subject. Text value returned, e.g. "Accountancy and Finance".
SubSubject	The course sub subject. Text value returned, e.g. "Bookkeeping"
CourseType	The course type. One of the values is returned: "Online", "Classroom", "DistanceLearning", "Software", "OnSite".
